


Basic rules of hitching

Be sure the slings you intend to use is strong enough for the job. Consult Manufacturer's Rated Capacity chart or refer to identification tag on the actual sling.

Control and balance


Use a hitch that will keep the load under control at all times and be sure the lifting device is directly over the center of gravity.








Measured Length

All web slings, chain slings, wire eye & eye slings and web sling bridle assemblies are measured pull to pull:











Wire Rope Multi-Leg bridle slings are all measured from thimble to hook. (Not including the master link):
